Grand Marshal, Bob Hoover exemplified the spirit of American fighting forces and demonstrated the power of American technology.

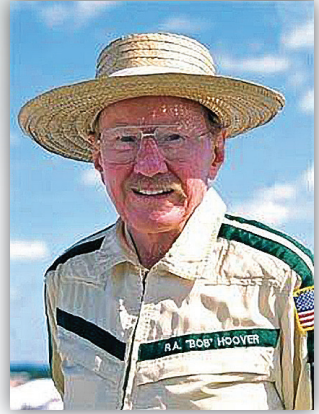
